Due to Post-Polio paralysis, Shahana was walking with a marked limp. At 10 years of age, her right leg was 2 inches shorter than her left, and this would have increased to 4 inches by age 16, affecting her overall health very badly. She is one of 4 children in an extremely poor family. Under our project, she received a hip-release operation, a limb-lengthening operation and finally correctional surgery in her right foot and ankle. Shahana is now undergoing physiotherapy and will soon be able to walk normally.
